

Cedarhill – Ottawa Valley Golf Association Intersectional Tryouts

The Ottawa Valley Golf Association (OVGA) Intersectional competitions are administrated by a host club in collaboration with the OVGA. They are considered by many to be the most exciting events on the OVGA schedule each year and the most competitive. In these events, teams from different clubs play head-to-head matches with accumulated points determining the winner of each division. If your Club wins the division it moves up a division next year. If you finished in 4th (last place) your club moves down a division. The 2nd and 3rd placed teams remain in that same division the next year, with the 2nd place team hosting that division.

Date and Location

The Ladies' OVGA Intersectional will be played on Sunday, July 16, 2017 at Sand Point (Arnprior), while the Men's OVGA Intersectional will be played on Sunday, July 9, 2017 at Algonquin.

Intersectional Team Selection Qualifier Registration

Players must register in order to compete in the Intersectional Qualifier. Players must register in order to compete in the Intersectional Qualifier. Registration sheets have been posted on the Club House bulletin boards and the Pro Shop.

The intersectional tryouts will be two counting rounds of golf. They will consist of one (1) of up to two (2) preliminary rounds (whose dates are flexible) and one (1) final fixed-date round.

Registration closes at noon on Friday, May 26, 2017.

Key Dates and Rules are attached and are posted on the Clubhouse bulletin boards.

OVGA Intersectional

The Ladies' OVGA Intersectional will be played on Sunday, July 16, 2017 at Sand Point (Arnprior), while the Men's OVGA Intersectional will be played on Sunday, July 9, 2017 at Algonquin.

Teams Selection

- a) The Ladies' team will consist of seven (7) players and one (1) alternate. Six (6) players will be selected through a qualifying competition. Cedarhill's Co-Club Captains will choose the final player. The alternate will be the next highest points qualifier not already selected by the Captain's pick.
- b) The Men's team will consist of ten (10) players and two (2) alternates. Eight (8) players will be selected through a qualifying completion. Cedarhill's Co-Club Captains will choose the final two players. The alternates will be the next two (2) highest points qualifiers not already selected by the Captain's picks.
- c) The Co-Club Captains will consult with the Playing Committee as appropriate.
- d) Performance during the qualifying rounds will be a major factor in the Co-Club Captains selection process.

Intersectional Qualifier

Registration:

Players must register in order to compete in the Intersectional Qualifier. Registration sheets have been posted on the Club House bulletin boards and the Pro Shop.

Registration closes at noon on Friday, May 26, 2017.

The intersectional tryouts will be two counting rounds of golf. They will consist of one (1) of up to two (2) preliminary rounds, whose dates are flexible and one (1) final fixed-date round.

Preliminary Round(s):

1. Players can play up to two (2) attested preliminary rounds.
2. One (1) attested preliminary round will count towards the player's final two round total score.
3. Players need to submit one attested preliminary round before competing in the final fixed-date round.
4. The preliminary round(s) must be played between May 27, 2017 and Thursday, June 15, 2017.
5. Ladies must play from the "red" tees.
6. Men must play from the "blue" tees.
7. The preliminary round(s) must be played with another intersectional qualifier registered player. This person does not necessarily have to be playing a qualifying round. Failing finding another intersectional qualifier registered player to play with, a player may play a qualifying round with a member of the Playing Committee.

8. The player must declare to both the Pro Shop and their playing partners that this will be one of their two attested preliminary rounds BEFORE they tee off on the first hole. (*The Pro Shop will be provided with a control sheet log*).
9. The signed (by both player and attester) card must be submitted to the Pro Shop immediately after the round or within 24 hours. Games played on Thursday June 15, 2017 must be submitted to the Pro Shop by noon Friday, June 16, 2017.

Final Intersectional Qualifier Round:

1. All players must compete in the Final Round.
2. The Final Round score will count towards the players' overall two-round total score.
3. The final round will be played on Saturday June 17, 2017.

Scoring

The Intersectional Qualifier (preliminary and final rounds) will use the Gross Stableford scoring format (see below).

Score	Points
Double Eagle	5
Eagle	4
Birdie	3
Par	2
Bogie	1
Double Bogie (or worse)	0

No points are awarded for a double-bogie or more. Please pick up after reaching a double-bogie.

Playing Conditions and Rules – Preliminary Round(s)

Given that all players are not playing the Preliminary Round(s) on the same day, to ensure fairness the following rules will apply:

- a) Play the ball down.
- b) All putts must be holed out - unless reaching or exceeding a double-bogie.
- c) Local rules as posted.

Playing Conditions and Rules – Final Round

The rules for the Final Round will be determined and announced on the first tee of the day of the event.

Entrance Fee

There is a \$10 entrance fee. The fee will be collected on the day of the final round.
