Senior Men's League

The League committee did an excellent job this year. Unfortunately, this year very early in the season, our Treasurer, Gerry Downey, was diagnosed with cancer and has been undergoing treatment all summer. In his absence, I have been trying to maintain our financial records.

Mike Calcutt once again resumed his tee master duties this year after a break last year for health issues. Paul Legendre continued as Draw Master. Bob Legault, in charge of purchasing prizes and maintaining and managing our inventory of prizes to ensure appropriate items were available each week as well as for the prize table layout you see here. Some statistics:

This year we started out with a bang and actually reached a tentative record 41 members enrolled in the seniors. Unfortunately, illnesses took their toll, and we finally ended the year with a membership of 39. We had 26 scheduled dates of which 24 of these were scheduled scoring days with two rained out leaving us with 22 scoring. We had 5 scheduled "away games" –Emerald Links, Loch March, Greensmere, Prescott and Kanata Lakes. Unfortunately, the Prescott game was rained out.

We managed to get a record 16 sponsors, three of whom, Meadowlands Roofing, Visual Planning and EdwardJones Investments sponsored 2 league days each for a total of 17 sponsored days. Two of the scheduled sponsors were unable to follow through.

Finally, it is worth noting that, in addition to the annual membership fee of \$50, essentially most of the final luncheon prize table is a result of sponsorships of, all told, a record \$2000 in cash, \$700 in coupons and about \$450 in-kind goods. In addition to the final prize table and during the year, these funds cover the cost of our luncheon and next spring's opening.

Various awards and recognitions this year are as follows:

Attendance-Two players this year had 100% attendance, attending all 22 of the counting games— Robert Legault and Bob Ferguson.

Overall Points Winner-The top scorer for the year is Bob Boynton with 147 points followed closely by Bob Legault with 143 points. Mr. Boynton gets a \$50 prize associated.

Havelin Cup Winner- Ron Wilkie won the Havelin Cup award this year with net 124 points beating out Gary Froats by 1 point over the two days. He receives a \$50 prize and his name has been added to the Havelin Cup. The trophy was first awarded in 1972 and was created by a Cedarhill member, John Havelin who was himself not a senior at the time. As you can see, it has a long history of champions.

Team Prize- Team 4 made up of Bob Legault, Dennis Brown, Ed Blais, Bruce Delaney and Brian Henderson were the first-place winners this year.
